Summary of Decisions Made:

- 1. Minutes (June 2023) were accepted.
- 2. Principal's Report (Annice Lappin) was accepted by the Council.
- 3. Future meeting dates for 2023
 - Term 4: Tuesday 28 November 2023 at 7:00pm (Term 4, Week 9)

Items for Discussion

1. *Camp Update* - At the June meeting, the preference to maintain the current camp structures was tabled by Council members. However, it has been decided that moving forward the 3/4 camp will be replaced with an 'extended day camp experience'.

Reasons include;

*the staffing requirements to maintain safe and above-required ratios

*the age appropriateness of the Year 3/4 students

*the emotional needs of the students

*the high risk and compliance processes associated with camp organisation and management The structure of the Year 5/6 Camp will remain unchanged.

- 2. 2024 School Timetable Annice and Marie have been working on different timetabling scenarios to meet the 21 hours scheduled class time requirements within the 30/8 model. If there needs to be a change to the bell times, advice gathered in the June meeting from the Council members to end the school day earlier rather than begin the school day later, will be actioned. It is hoped that the 2024 school timetable will be confirmed and published by Term 4, Week 3.
- 3. 2024 Class Structures The 2024 Class Structures will remain the same as 2023;
 - *2 x Foundation, 3 x Year 1/2, 3 x Year 3/4, 3 x Year 5/6

*a Learning Leader will also be placed in junior, middle and senior cohorts to support the school's approach to learning and wellbeing

Annual Review Meetings have been conducted and placement of teaching staff will be confirmed early in Term 4.

- 4. *MACS 2030 Strategy* The MACS 2030 Strategy was tabled. In August 2021, MACS embarked on researching, designing and developing its 2030 strategy. This strategy provides direction and goals for Catholic Schools in the Archdiocese of Melbourne.
- 5. *MACS Flourishing Learners* Annice has been invited to participate in the Flourishing Learners Reference Group. A current MACS goal is for all schools to move towards a knowledge rich evidence based program. This instructional practice is already embedded at St Mary's School.

Other Discussion:

6. Languages at St Mary's School (Ben) - Despite 3 attempts at advertising this position (Term 4, 2022 - Term 1, 2023), the position of Italian Teacher/Assistant remained unfilled for 2023. For this year, a Language Leader in each teaching team was appointed. Language Leaders meet termly with Dianne Dolley to plan for the term ahead (scope and sequence, slides, resources, gesture videos) and oversee the daily Italian practice within their own teams. The position of Language assistant will be advertised in Term 4, 2023.
