Why Arriving on Time Matters

Arriving at school on time each day helps set children up for a calm and confident start. Those first minutes of the school day are important — they're when teachers explain the day ahead, take attendance, and help students settle into learning. When children arrive late, even by a few minutes, they can miss key instructions and feel rushed or unsettled as they try to catch up.

Being on time also supports children's wellbeing. A predictable morning routine helps reduce anxiety and builds independence, responsibility and confidence. Over time, punctuality becomes a valuable life skill that supports learning, friendships and positive habits.

We appreciate the efforts families make to get children to school each day. By working together to prioritise punctuality, we can help every child start their day feeling calm, connected and ready to learn.

Our GEM Chats are designed to spark discussions and inspire the practical use of **Gratitude**, **Empathy** and **Mindfulness** principles in a range of settings. We encourage you to ask the fortnightly question on the way to school, on the way home or even over the weekend.

Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)

Reminder: Parents/Carers/Guardians holding a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent as at first student day, **28 January 2026**, may be eligible for the Victorian Government's Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF) which assists eligible families by providing payments to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. In 2026 the amount will increase from \$154 to \$400 for eligible primary school students. The allowance will be paid directly to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions/incursions, or sporting activities for the benefit of your child. NOTE: Families who qualify for CSEF may also be eligible for Fee Assistance through the School Fees Concession Program.
