As we begin Term 2, I look forward to a productive eleven weeks, filled with learning, fun and many engaging, school community activities. Classroom teachers will send home learning overviews this week and a student progress report will be emailed home at the end of the term. Please discuss your child's learning with them and encourage them to achieve their best.

The last day of Term 1 was very exciting with Ollie M and Jaco leading our school as principals for the day. They led the school beautifully and also drew the winners of the Easter Raffle. Congratulations to the winners; The Bentley Family (Archie and Arabella), The Flanders Family (Maci) and the McMahon Family (Maisie). Thank you to everyone who purchased tickets and thank you to Simone Shannon, Teonie Humphrey and Angela McMahon from the P&FA who organised this fundraising event. This week, four additional shade sails are being installed along the east side of our grassed space. Once these are installed, some physical education storage sheds will be installed, making it easier for sporting equipment to be accessed.

Hats must continue to be worn by students until 1 May. Please support your child by ensuring they leave home each morning, in their full, correct uniform, which is clean and in good repair. Students must present a note, written by a parent/guardian in the event that they are not wearing the correct school uniform, on a particular day.

Next Wednesday is our annual School Athletics Day. Important information about this much anticipated event includes;



BEFORE SCHOOL

- Students wear their sport uniform on this day house coloured t-shirts can be worn
- Apply sunscreen students will be encouraged to reapply sunscreen during the day

Students can bring a smaller back pack (or use school bags) to carry healthy snacks, lunch and a bottle filled with water



AT SCHOOL

- Entry to learning spaces will be from 8:30am aim to arrive at school by 8:45am
- The school hat must be worn hats will be placed on student desks on Tuesday afternoon
- All classes will be ready at 8:55am, leaving for Landy Field at 9:00am sharp
- Late arrivals after 8:50am must report to administration parents/carers/guardians will be responsible for taking their child to Landy Field if their class has already left the school's grounds



DURING THE DAY AT LANDY FIELD

- Foundation students sit together as a cohort group
- Years 1-6 students sit in their house groups Mannix, Mercy or McAuley
- Foundation Year 2 students participate in their scheduled activities in year level / class groups
- Year 3 Year 6 students participate in their scheduled events in age groups
- For adults, a coffee van is available for purchases at own cost
- A First Aid station, led by school staff, is available throughout the day
- The timetable for the day is a guide only announcements are made throughout the day



CHILD SAFETY - IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

- Parent Helpers: Adults who are assisting with the day's events must provide a copy of their valid Working with Children card to administration, prior to the day
- Student Sign In: Students meeting their class at Landy Field must be signed in using the school's VPASS QR Code by a parent/carer/guardian
- Student Sign Out: Students who do not return to school with their class (12:45pm for F-2 students and 2:40pm for 3-6 students) must be signed out using the school's VPASS QR Code by a parent/carer/guardian

F-2 students who remain at Landy Field after 12:45pm will be supervised by their parent/carer/guardian






ST MARY'S PARISH is having an Anzac Day Mass on Thursday, 25 April at 9:00am.


