#### News from the Principal

Dear Families,

Welcome to Term 4! It was lovely to speak with many students as they entered the school grounds over the past few days. Many were able to retell their holiday experiences with delight and joy. Our last day of Term 3 saw **Nina** (Foundation Coral) as our **Principal for a Day**. Nina was a very popular choice and she granted the students the opportunity to dress in pyjamas or footy colours and have extra play.



Social Catholic Teaching is a very important aspect of St Mary's School. On the last day of term, a small group of Year 1/2 students presented Alan from the Parish Pantry with approximately \$130, raised from the sale of friendship bands, made and sold by these students. This is social justice in action! Alan extended his thanks and presented each of the students with a certificate of appreciation. This Friday, 7 October, we will celebrate Mercy Feast Day which was during the holidays on 24 September. Everyone is asked to wear a touch of blue. As on previous Feast Days, to make it very easy for families, students can wear their school uniform with a touch of blue (Eg, ribbon, socks, etc.) or casual clothes with blue (Eg, Tshirt, shorts, etc.) No money needs to be brought to school on the day, as this is covered in the Events and Activities' Levy. 
On Monday morning, Foundation students participated in the GMHBA Geelong Cats Healthy Heroes session. Students were joined by Education Team Members and the Geelong Cats Club mascot, Half-Cat, in sharing some of their key messages around being a Healthy Hero. This was an immersion into the learning students are going to undertake in our Core Knowledge unit about making healthy choices. Our presenters encouraged the students to listen and learn about the healthy messages in the areas of physical activity, healthy eating, wellbeing, sleep and screen time.

Some of the key messages included:

- screen time = less than 2 hours per day
- hydration = drink 7 glasses of water per day
- physical activity = 60 minutes every day (and does not need to be at once)
- healthy eating = eat 5 serves of vegetables and 2 serves of fruit a day
- wellbeing = there are 2 character strengths that when actioned enhance our wellbeing
- sleep = children this age needs 9 to 11 hours sleep each night
